Her current areas of research are mainly focused on Development of the Chinese commercial legal framework; Chinese environmental policy; Chinese healthcare sector; Foreign direct investment and Offshore foreign direct investments (Europe-China); Chinese E-commerce Legal Framework & IP infringements; The role of the entrepreneurship in Chinese society and non state sector in China.

She teaches Chinese Commercial Law at University of Macerata, Department of Political Science, Communication and International Relations; Elements of Chinese Law and Chinese Juridical Lexicon at Confucius Institute, in Macerata.
