Since May 2013, Ms. Ivana GASKOVA has been a Research Fellow at University Institute of European Studies – IUSE, Turin (Italy).

Previously, she worked as foreign expert at China Radio International (中国国际广播电台), Beijing, China, for 5 years from 2007 to 2012.

She was also Research Fellow at University of Eastern Piedmont (Università degli Studi del Piemonte Orientale Amedeo Avogadro), Novara, Italy, and at University Institute for European Studies – IUSE (Istituto Universitario di Studi Europei), Turin, Italy, within EU Commission funded research projects on sustainable development, climate change, energy, environmental protection, and public health.

Since March 2013, she has been EU Commission Marie Curie Fellow at Tsinghua University, Beijing, China, and at Peking University, School of Government, Center for European Studies, Beijing, China.
